SAFA RULE BOOK
June 27, 2015

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

1. US citizens and eligible voters who are farming and residing on Saipan can participate in the fair.
2. Only produce grown on Saipan shall be entered in the competition. The farmer or individual contestant or his/her immediate family must have grown the produce. Produce bought or borrowed from stores, or from other farmers will be disqualified and will not be eligible for entry to compete.
3. Only animals raised on Saipan shall be entered in the competition.
4. Animals and plants produce to be on display for competition and judging must be clean, properly packaged or suitably arranged on the counter or in a suitable container, cage, corral, etc., and must be properly numbered or identified.
5. Prior to distribution of the cash and other awards, SAFA, with the assistance of DLNR's Division of Agriculture staff, will verify if each winner is a bona fide farmer and a registered Saipan voter and/or a U.S citizen, and can prove, by showing the SAFA Rules Compliance Staff, that the winning entries registered in the winning person's name were, in fact, grown on that person's farm or garden. No cash or any award will be made or given out for failure to provide such proof. The farm visits will be conducted within two weeks before close of the Agriculture Fair.

FEES

1. Plant Division: A non-refundable registration fee of **\$10.00** per participation/entrant and **\$2.00** for each produce entry.
2. Animal Division: A non-refundable registration fee of **\$15.00** per participant/entrant and **\$3.00** for each livestock or animal entry.
3. Hauling: The following hauling fees shall be charged to each participant:

- * Swine: \$20.00 per hauling, round trip
- * Cattle: \$20.00 per hauling, round trip
- * Swine: \$10.00 one-way trip
- * Cattle: \$15.00 one-way trip

Only one animal per hauling is allowed for transportation to the fair site and return.

III. TIME:

1. Hauling of cattle and swine to the fair site shall be from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm on Friday, **June 26, 2015**. Deadline for registration of large animals (cattle and swine) shall be on Thursday, **June 25, 2015** at 4:30 pm. The Chair of Rules Committee, in consultation with the Animal Division Chair, may extend the hauling and registration deadline if deemed reasonable, appropriate or necessary. All other animal entries must be registered by 6:00 am on Saturday, **June 27, 2015** at the fair site. All entries brought after the designated date and time shall not be accepted.
2. **All exhibits/entries in the plant division will be returned back to the owner / farmer once the exhibits closes.**
3. All exhibits shall be opened to the general public immediately after judging is completed and shall remain open until 3:00 pm Saturday, **June 27, 2015**.
4. For the Plant Division, the registration for perishable and non-perishable entries shall start at **1:00 pm to 10:00 pm on June 26, 2015**.

JUDGING:

1. Employees of the respective divisions shall not be eligible to judge.
2. Judges and their immediate families are not eligible to enter in their respective divisions, but may do so in other division's competition.
3. Judging shall be done by a panel of three judges for each division, and shall be on a point system based on the visual outlook including but not limited to size, form, condition, quality, attractiveness, etc. Produce may be cut open for taste, aroma, coloring, etc. In the event a display product in the Plant Division is requested by a judge or panel of judges to be tested or cut open for whatever reason, then the same will apply to all other entries within the same category. There shall be uniformity in the manner of judging for each and every entry category.
4. Judging shall start promptly at 6:00 am on Saturday, **June 27, 2015** for produce and animals.
5. During the judging of animals and produce, only the judges and Agricultural Fair Association officers are authorized in the display area.
6. All decisions of the judges are final.

V. AWARDS:

1. There will be no points given to produce or animals (livestock) which did not win the 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place, in both Plant and Animal Division.
2. Honorary mentions shall be awarded 1 point.
3. There will be no consolation prizes for both Plant Division and Animal Division.
4. The grand prize winner, one for the Plant Division and one for the Animal Division, shall be the participant who garnered the most points.
5. Grand prize for the Plant and Animal Division will be in the form of cash prize worth **\$500** for each division.
6. Awarding of ribbons for the individual categories in the Plant and Animal Divisions shall take place immediately after the judging.
7. All award prizes will be in the form of cash or equivalent

VI. LIABILITY:

The Department of Lands and Natural Resources, Division of Agriculture, CNMI Government, NMC-CREES or the Saipan Agricultural Fair Association assumes no liability for the loss of plant materials, either from natural breakdown during the exhibit, opening/tasting by the judges or theft. Representatives of the plant and animal divisions will be present throughout the time of exhibition to minimize such loss.

Furthermore, Saipan Agricultural Fair and its Partners will not be liable for any accident, injury, death or food poisoning that took place at the official site of the fair.

VII. OTHERS:

1. No more than one immediate member of a family member shall be permitted to enter a particular category.
2. Contestants may enter as many categories as they wish, however, only their best must be entered in each category.

3. Produce for competition must meet local market standards or better. Only a single contestant may enter the required number of plant materials and produce. No more or less than that number will be accepted. No wild papayas shall be enterable.
4. If any question, dispute, etc. should raise pertaining to the fair rules and entry conditions and requirements, then the answer or decision of the Rules Committee Chairperson, in consultation with the Division Chair that is affected or concerned, shall be final.
5. Dogs, cats, horses, exotic birds, fish, food preserves, etc. are not eligible or acceptable for entry in any contest, but may be displayed for admiration, advertisement or for sale. However, no clothing, shoes, kitchenware, handicrafts (except locally made) and other items or produce not allowed by the Board shall be displayed or sold. The Rules Committee Chair, together with the Plant and Animal Chairpersons, shall decide what other items or products may not be sold or displayed. Only those livestock animals and produce listed in the rule booklet will be accepted for entry into the various contest categories.
6. Gilt is considered below one year old with no offspring.
7. Miscellaneous produce entries will be for display purposes only and will not be eligible for competition.

**2015 Youth Agricultural Fair
Rules and Regulations**

I. Mandatory Requirements

1. All youths, ages 8-18, 4H Club Members or non-member are eligible to enter.
2. Only produce listed in Section VII of the 2015 Youth Rules and Regulations will be accepted as entries in this year's fair. Note: All produce listed must be grown on Saipan.
3. Youths are permitted to enter in any category, provided that the exhibit is registered with the 4H-Agent at NMC-CREES.
4. Parents of participating youths will be responsible for transporting their children and display produced to and from the fair.
5. Produce on display must be in accordance with the number or amount listed in Section VII of the 2015 Rules and Regulations. Note: for more information please contact Polly Omechelang. Telephone No. 237-6851 or 285-3240

II. Fees

No participant shall be subject to any fee to enter this competition.

III. Time

1. All parents of participants who are entering the 2015 Youth Fair are required to bring their entries to the Fairground located near the 4H Building in Susupe on Friday, June 26, 2015 between 6pm to 10pm.
2. All entries brought after the designated time and date will not be eligible to judge.

IV. Judging

1. Employees of NMC-CREES' Saipan Campus and parents of participating youths are not eligible to judge.
2. Judging of produce will take place at 6:30am on Saturday morning June 27, 2015.
